STATE PRESCHOOL NOW ENROLLING FOR 2010/2011

Free State Preschool Program!

We are now accepting applications for the 2010/2011 school year for participation in our State Preschool program. State Preschool is available free of charge to eligible families of preschool age children. Eligibility is determined by family income, family size, and age of child.

APPLICATIONS

To be considered for enrollment, a Centralized Eligibility List application must be completed and returned to one of the following school sites; Baldy Mesa, Phelan, Pinon Hills, Vista Verde, or Wrightwood Elementary School. The application is available at www.snowlineschools.com and can be completed electronically, printed, and then returned to one of the above listed school sites. Applications are also available in the school offices. For immediate consideration, please submit applications to the school sites.

Qualifying families will be contacted by the State Preschool staff for an eligibility appointment to further establish eligibility and to begin the enrollment process.

Who can attend State preschool?

Children who turn 4 years old on or before December 2 of the upcoming school year are given first priority. Children who turn 3 years old after December 2 may be enrolled if there are no 4 year old students on the waiting list.

When and where is the program offered?

The State Preschool program is offered at Baldy Mesa, Phelan, Pinon Hills, Vista Verde, and Wrightwood Elementary School. Classes meet for 3 hours on all regular school days. Morning and afternoon classes are offered at Baldy Mesa, Phelan, and Vista Verde Elementary School.

ADMISSION PRIORITIES

First Priority:

- Child Protective Service Referrals for 3 & 4 year olds regardless of income.
- Children who will be four (4) years old by December 2, 2010. Families with lowest income shall be admitted first.

Second Priority:

- Children who are going to be age four (4) years by December 2, 2011.
- Families with lowest income shall be admitted first.

Third Priority:

- Military families whose income does not exceed 15% over the income schedule when deducting their BAH.

Applicants must bring the following documents to their eligibility appointment. These documents are used to determine eligibility:

- ✓ Birth Certificate or baptismal certificate for **each** child listed in the family size (*Hospital issued certificates are not acceptable*)
- ✓ Income Verification for **all** adults counted in the family size. For all adults in the family size currently employed, check stubs **from the past 2 months** are used to verify income.
- ✓ Child Support documentation (*if applicable*)
- ✓ Guardianship Court Documents (*if applicable*)
- ✓ Income Tax Return for past year if self-employed
