**VACATION LEAVE FOR CERTIFICATED MANAGERS**

A month of service for purposes of vacation accrual is defined as a month in which the employee is paid for more than one-half of the working days in that month.

- Vacation days must be earned in advance of taking vacation leave. Any exception to this requirement must have prior approval of the Superintendent.
