

PARENTS:

Children need to have these shots and a physical before they can begin school.

Children entering child care should have:

Age when enrolling:

- 2-3 months
- 4-5 months
- 6-14 months
- 15-17 months
- 18 months – 4 years

Immunizations required:

- 1 DTaP, 1 Polio, 1 Hep B, 1 Hib
- 2 DTaP, 2 Polio, 2 Hep B, 2 Hib
- 3 DTaP, 2 Polio, 2 Hep B, 2 Hib
- 3 DTaP, 3 Polio, 2 Hep B, 1 MMR*, 1 Hib*
- 4 DTaP, 3 Polio, 3 Hep B, 1 MMR*, 1 Hib**
- 1 Varicella

* on or after the first birthday

** on or after the first birthday, regardless of any Hib doses given before the first birthday

Children entering Kindergarten should have:

- 5 DTaP (4 doses meet requirement if at least one was given on or after the 4th birthday)
- 4 Polio (3 doses meet requirement if at least one was given on or after 4th birthday)
- 3 Hep B
- 2 MMR (both on or after 1st birthday)
- 1 Varicella

Look: new state requirement!

Children entering 7th – 12th grade MUST have:

- Tdap Pertussis **BOOSTER****

NEW REQUIREMENT FROM STATE EFFECTIVE 7/1/2011

Children entering 7th grade should have:

- 2 MMR (both on or after 1st birthday)
- 1 Varicella (2 doses are needed if immunized on or after 13th birthday)
- Td Booster (recommended)

Children graduating from High School and entering college:

All above listed in Kindergarten and

- 1 Polio (booster for international)*
- 2 Hep A*
- Td Booster (needed every 10 years)*
- 3 Hep B ** (or 2 doses of the 2 dose formulation)
- 1 Influenza (annually)*
- 1 Meningiococcal*
- 1 Pneumococcal*

* - Recommended ** - Required

See your child's doctor to make sure your child's immunization record has dates for these shots. You will need to show your child's yellow immunization record to register your child for school.
