Kindergarten Entry Physical Exam Information

Snowline Joint Unified School board policy 5112.3 a. and b. requires a certificate of physical examination be provided to the school upon entry into Kindergarten. The examination must be done within 90 days of the child entering kindergarten, **but not more than 6 months before** your child enters kindergarten.

A health screening is important because your child may appear healthy, but still have a health problem that could interfere with his/her education. Health problems found early are easier to treat and correct and save medical costs.

If your child is under the constant medical supervision of a physician for regular health check ups or a medical condition, or if he/she has had a recent physical, it is not necessary to have an additional examination. Simply take the "Health Examination for School Entry" form to your child's doctor, have it signed and return it to school. If your child still needs a physical examination, please arrange for that to be completed by your child's own physician and return the completed form to the school **no later than 90 days after entry into kindergarten.**

If your child does not have health insurance, your child may qualify for a CHDP school entrance examination at no cost to you. Free Health Screenings are available for children of families with low-income through the San Bernardino County Public Health Department.
